## The Pinn Medical Centre Patients' Association is looking for new Trustees

The Pinn Medical Centre Patients' Association (PMCPA) is the official Patient Participation Group (PPG) for the Pinn Medical Centre and as such we are the main forum for consultation between patients and the Practice.

In addition we provide the following services:

- Receiving and providing feedback from patients
- Transport for vulnerable patients to medical appointments
- Providing a network of support for Carers
- Volunteer help for the National anti-Covid Vaccination Programme
- Creating and delivering the Pinn Piper
- Fundraising and Quiz Nights
- Healthcare information

We are looking to enhance our role by increasing a range of services to support individuals and groups within the community. Lately we have launched:

- Mobility classes
- Digital inclusion classes

We are about to provide other services providing support groups in:

- Patients experiencing menopause
- Health and well-being for men
- Managing a family budget
- Basic DIY support
- Shopping support
- Friendship group
- Healthy walks

You may have ideas of other groups you would like to see us provide – let us know, or better still, join us to make it happen !!

There is now a much more formal recognition than ever before of the importance of voluntary patient groups like ours, and the need to bring out the largely untapped potential of such groups to improve the quality of healthcare delivery nationwide. Patient participation is now increasingly seen as playing a crucial part in helping GP practices to identify more precisely what is important to patients and how it can improve its service to them. We are a thriving organisation, having doubled our Membership over the last year. But we need to do more, not least in respect of patient/member involvement.

### We are now keen to appoint at least FOUR new Trustees to serve on the Board.

The time commitment is for five meetings a year (four Board Meetings and the Annual General Meeting) although our Trustees take part in many other activities to support patients and to develop the work of the Association.

If you are interested in joining the PMCPA as a Trustee, and are interested in supporting the Practice and its patients, we'd love to hear from you.



It would be useful if **you had skills and** experiences in the areas outlined below. We would certainly make full use of them:

- Management and organisation of particular services and events;
- Charity Law; Board/Company Secretary;
- Health and social services;
- Public education campaigns and activities;
- Marketing: Event promotion, Advertising sales; design; editorial; Press and Media;
- Information Technology, including website support.

However, we are not looking for only professional people who fit a rigid template. We are looking for people who may well regard themselves as being from a non-professional background – perhaps you may not have a full employment record - but what you will have is a keen desire to help others and more importantly the drive to get things done.

Trustee positions are open to all patients over the age of 16 and who are registered as patients with the Pinn Medical Centre, regardless of age (there is no upper age limit), gender, race, faith, disability or sexual orientation.

In order to help achieve a balance of views, insights, and beliefs that are representative of the PMC's patient population, however, and to address UK Government and NHS directives on overcoming historic under-representation in public decision-making at senior levels, applications are particularly welcome from such groups as under-40's; people with disabilities; women; and so forth.
